Phonics

Reception have been revising the tricky words and the sounds taught last term. They have been practising reading words with two or more digraphs and words ending in s/es.

Year One have started to revise and recap their previous learning for the Phonics' screening test later this year. They have revised the following sounds this week: ay (e.g. play), a-e (e.g. shake), ea (e.g. each) and e (e.g. he).

Maths

Reception and Year One have both been completing Maths Assessments this week and recapping on their previous learning from last term.

Drawing Club- We have focussed on the story *The Odd Egg* to consolidate our learning about Birds and Reptiles last term! The children have explored the characters (the duck), setting (the nest) and used their imaginations to change the story such as, Duck has found another egg, what will it look like and what will the creature be? We have explored new vocabulary relating to the story such as, emerge, incubate, demolish, armour, fracture, flourish, plume and cherish. We added actions to help us remember them! Year one have focussed on using adjectives and retelling the story. Reception have focussed on thinking of and remembering a simple sentence before writing it.

A reminder that it is our class trip to Muddy Education next week (Wednesday), so please ensure your child comes in suitable clothing and that you have either provided a packed lunch for your child or ordered a packed lunch option through Kingswood. Any hot meals already ordered should be cancelled.
